

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CONTEST MECHANICS:

1. Participants

The activity will be participated in by **Grade 4 to Grade 6 students**, composed of a total of **100 participants** — **60 from public schools** and **40 from private schools** within the city. These participants will represent their respective schools in a friendly competition that promotes teamwork, sportsmanship, and appreciation of traditional Filipino games.

2. Teams

All **100 participants** will be **divided into four (4) groups**, each consisting of **25 members**. The grouping aims to ensure equal participation and balanced representation from both public and private schools. Each team will take turns participating in the different games and will be scored based on performance, teamwork, and adherence to the rules. The City Sports Office will determine the groupings.

3. Games

The activity will feature the following **traditional Filipino games**, designed to encourage physical activity, camaraderie, and cultural appreciation among the students:

3.1. Patintero – A team game where players try to cross lines without being tagged by the opposing team.

Objective: To accumulate the most points by having the member who reaches the farthest within the allotted time.

3.2. Tumbang Preso – A popular game that involves knocking down a can using slippers while avoiding being tagged by the "guard."

Objective: To accumulate the most points by knocking down the slipper on the can within the allotted time.

3.3. Tayakad sa Kahoy – A game of balance and coordination where participants walk or race using bamboo or wooden stilts.

Objective: To record the fastest time going to and returning from the designated line using a piece of wood.

3.4. Batuhang Bola – A dodgeball-type game where players aim to hit opponents with a ball while avoiding being hit themselves.

Objective: To record the shortest time by counting the remaining members after the game.

3.5. Luksong Tsinelas – A jumping game similar to *luksong baka*, where players leap over a pile of slippers that increases in height each round.

Objective: To record the farthest distance jumped.
