1. In line with the recently conducted MTAP-MATH Challenge Elimination Round, the following are qualified to participate in the DIVISION-DEPED Math Challenge Team Orals for elementary and secondary schools at Tayabas East Central School II on March 16-17, 2017
2. Pursuant to the 2017 METROBANK MTAP-DEPED CHALLENGE Guidelines, the number of teams qualified to join in the Division Final Round (elementary and secondary) is dependent on the number of participating schools in the elimination round. If the participating schools are less than 15, the top six are qualified to participate. In the secondary with only 4 schools, all are qualified.


