- With its mission to promote and sustain excellence in campus journalism, DepEd Tayabas City, in cooperation with the Regional Association of School Paper Advisers (RASPA), and Regional Association of Communication Arts Supervisors (RACAS) will conduct the 2018 Regional Training in Campus Journalism Caravan which will highlight seminar- workshops in school paper management and campus journalism categories for Quezon Province and Tayabas City Cluster on May 10-12, 2018 at Quezon National High School, Iyam, Lucena City.
- Specifically, the training aims to strengthen Quezon and Tayabas School Paper Advisers' competence in producing quality and winnable school publication and promote sharing of best practices among the Most Outstanding School Paper Advisers (MOSPA), NSPC winning SPAs and Regional cliniquing facilitators/ trainers.
- 3. This 3-day training is live-out. Each participant shall be responsible for their own transportation, food, accommodation and other related expenses which may be charged to MOOE, provincial local funds or the city's special education fund and others subject to availability of fund and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 4. Registration will start at 7:00 am to 7:30 am. Opening program follows observing Juan Time Policy.
- 5. The list of identified participants to attend the training in elementary and secondary schools is attached. Please send a <u>replacement</u> if they cannot attend the said training to ensure that the expected hundred participants from Tayabas City will be met.

 the training.
- 7. A three-day service credit leave shall be given to the teacher-participants while one-day compensatory leave shall be given to SDO Officials/ employee for attending the weekend activity.
