Specifically, the training aims to strengthen reading teachers (English and Filipino) and School Paper Advisers' competence in producing literate students/ functional readers and quality and winnable school publication and promote sharing of best practices among Regional cliniquing facilitators/trainers.
3. It is open to all interested teachers preferably the identified school reading specialist and chief school paper adviser/ journalism coordinator, department heads and school heads.
4. The registration of Php 5, 000 inclusive of food (2 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 5 snacks and 2 dinners), hotel accommodation, seminar materials, certificates, and speakers' honoraria, and transportation and other related expenses may be charged to MOOE, provincial local funds or the city's Special Education Fund, and others subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The proceeds of these projects shall be utilized for the RACAS Scholarship Program.
6. A three-day service credit/ compensatory leave shall be given to participants for attending the training.


