1. Pursuant to the DepEd trust, norms and standard on producing holistic and productive personnel, a Teachers Capacity Development Program (TCDP) is an important component of the Teacher Education and Development Program (TEDP) which provides a continuum from pre-service to in-service training. In support of this, training workshop will be held on June 12-14, 2018 at ORN Hall Luis Palad Integrated High School.
2. The TCDP aims to:
 - A. Deepen understanding on the implementation of SHS Curriculum for Grades 11 & 12.
 - B. Identify specific strategies and tools for classroom based assessment on SHS Curriculum.
 - C. Conduct demonstration teaching applying learned pedagogical approaches and classroom based assessment.
 - D. Appreciate the importance of deepened understanding on the implementation of SHS Curriculum for Grades 11 & 12
3. The expected participants are all SHS Teachers from Luis Palad Integrated High School and Tayabas City Division Stand-Alone Senior High School. The participants are requested to bring laptop and curriculum guide for Junior High School and Senior High School. Training Matrix and List of Participants are in Enclosures 1 and 2.
4. A registration fee of One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (1,800) for three (3) days shall be allotted per participant to cover TDCP expenses, such as foods, materials and kits, and other incidental expenses charged against school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
