**SUBJECT : 8<sup>th</sup> DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (DSPC)**

**DATE : AUGUST 27, 2019**

1. DepEd Tayabas City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the conduct of the **8<sup>th</sup> Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) for S.Y. 2019-2020** on September 12, 2019 tentatively at Saint John Bosco Academy in preparation for the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) on November 2019 in Antipolo, Rizal.

2. The conduct of the DSPC is pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, and in support to DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2010, entitled Guidelines on Financial Subsidy for the Conduct of the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC), its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) specifically Rule IX of Section 1.

3. The Conference aims to:

- demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
- sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
- provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
- promote responsible journalism and fair ethical use of social media; and
- enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.

4. The Conference activities shall include the following:

- Individual Contests (News, Editorial, Column, Cartooning, Features, Science, Sports, Photojournalism, Copy reading and Headline Writing);
- Collaborative Desktop Publishing (CDP) Contests;
- Scriptwriting and Radio Broadcasting Contests;
- Scriptwriting and TV Broadcasting Contests (Secondary only)



- e. Online Publishing (Secondary only); and
- f. School Paper Contests;

5. DepEd is a staunch advocate of smart, creative and original expression of thoughts and ideas. The Department respects Intellectual Property Rights and adheres to the rule of law concerning plagiarism. Any printed or online publication found to have copied and published texts, graphics and other materials, without duly acknowledging their sources, will be disqualified from the competition. The disqualification covers all sections of the school paper whether they are published in print or electronic copy.

6. In order to clarify issues and concerns regarding the conduct of the Schools Conferences, School Paper Advisers, are advised to refer to the implementing guidelines stipulated in DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2010. The Guidelines of the Individual and Group Contests are stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 9, s. 2014. Any violation of the stipulated guidelines is subject for disqualification.

7. All participating schools should follow the **“No School Paper, No Student Contestant Policy”**. Schools which have collected journalism or subscription fees from their students should submit school paper entries.

8. Each school is expected to submit the list of official delegates using the format provided in Enclosure 1. Participating schools should also fill up the Online Registration Form using the link provided by DASPA President Alfonso Mabuting.

9. Students in the elementary and secondary (both junior and senior high schools) levels are eligible to join the contests.

10. In the individual and group contests, **two (2) students/ group** will be allowed to participate per category per school.

11. There will be a **P 400 REGISTRATION FEE** which may be charged to local funds, campus journalism fund/ campus publication fund/ PTA fund, stakeholders' contribution subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. This will be used for the honoraria, board and lodging and transportation of judges, supplies and other related expenses.

12. All delegation heads must be responsible not only for the food, accommodation and transportation of their Campus Journalists (CJ's)/ students but also for their safety and security all throughout the DSPC. Thus, the parents' permit together with the schools' official lists of participants duly signed by the school principal must be submitted to the registration committee.



13. To ensure a smooth and orderly conduct of the 8<sup>th</sup> DSPC, the Division Association of School Paper Advisers (DASPA) Officers and members of the Technical Working Group (TWG) are expected to be in the venue (SJBA) on **September 11, 2019 (Day 0) at 1:00 PM** for the preparation of materials while the School Paper Advisers (SPAs) shall attend the Orientation Meeting/ briefing and pre-registration at **3:00 PM** in the same date and venue.
14. DSPC pre-planning Activity shall be conducted on **August 30, 2019** tentatively at St. John Bosco Academy, 3:00 PM.
15. The host school is also requested to prepare the venue, stage, and accommodation, sound system, ICT (projectors and white screens), medical and security.
16. DASPA Officers and coaches of DSPC Winners will have a review meeting/ RSPC planning on **September 24, 2019** tentatively at Tayabas West Central School I at 3:00 P.M.
