- f. Conduct demonstration lesson using MG DLP and IMG LP

Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity which include materials and foods for 2 days shall be charged against 2018 Financial Support for Multigrade Schools while travelling expenses and other incidental expenses may be charged against school funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
