**General Guidelines for the Conduct of the Division Kindergarten Festival of Talents (DKFT)
for Public and Private Schools**

1. Each school both public and private shall conduct their own competitions to select the best contestants in all the categories on October 9 to 13, 2017.
2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled Kindergarten pupils in public and private schools.
3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
4. Only the school/cluster champions in public and private schools per category are qualified to join the Division Festival of Talents.
5. The number of the contestants in the registration form shall be his/her official number during the contest.
6. There will be only one contest piece for storytelling.
7. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly.
8. Winners per category will be identified per criteria by the Board of Judges

All winners in public and private will be determined thru point system.

Category	Individual	Group
First	15	30
Second	10	20
Third	5	10

Total points garnered in each group (public and private) shall be consolidated to get the over-all champion.

9. All winners will receive medals – 1st gold, 2nd silver and 3rd bronze and Certificate of Recognition
10. The panel of judges shall be composed of a Chairman and 2 members. The decision of the board of judges is final.





Specific Guidelines

STORY TELLING

1. Contestants will be gathered in the assigned room.
 2. Coaches and parents are not allowed to mingle with the contestant as the competition starts.
 3. Each contestant will be given a maximum time of 5 minutes to deliver the piece.
 4. The winner will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the general criteria below:
 - A. Story Content - 50%
 - Accuracy of recalled events – 20%
 - Organization of events/ideas including inference from texts - 15%
 - Accurate outlining of the sequence of events as they happened in the story -15%
 - B. Voice Projection/Verbal Style - 20%
 - C. Expression/Distinct Style – 20%
 - D. Level of Confidence - 10%
- Total 100%**

VOCAL SOLO COMPETITION

1. Each contestant is free to choose any song provided the song chosen is appropriate to children.
2. Performance time is 2 -3 minutes including entrance and exit
3. Minus-one music or live piano or guitar can be used as accompaniment; however, contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.

1. Contestants will be gathered in the assigned room.
2. Coaches and parents are not allowed to mingle with the contestant as the competition starts.
3. The contest will be in 3 hours' time.
4. Each contestant shall provide his/her own materials:
 - a. 1 also paper
 - b. Single Kiddie Crayon
 - c. Jumbo pencil
5. The winner will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the general criteria below.





Originality/Creativity/Artistry (Is there balance among the lines, colors, forms and values)	40%
Relevance/Appropriateness (Does it show clear, appropriate to the theme? Does it present many Ideas as possible to show vividly the theme)	30%
Visual Impact (Is there sufficient movement so that the onlooker is led to look Exciting? Is it interesting and enjoyable to look at?)	30%
TOTAL	100%

Clay and Modelling Contest

1. Contestants will be gathered in the assigned room.
2. The contest is composed of three (3) members per school
3. Coaches and parents are not allowed to mingle with the contestant as the competition starts.
4. The contest will be in 3 hours' time.
5. Each contestant shall provide his/her own materials:
 - a. $\frac{1}{4}$ illustration board as mounting board
 - b. Clay
6. The winner will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the general criteria below:

Understanding the Theme	30%
Narrating Skills	30%
Neatness/Creativity and Artistry	30%
Time Management (completing within the time limit)	10%
TOTAL	100%
