General Guidelines for the Conduct of Shine – 2017 Teachers' Festival of Talents

3. The number of the contestants in the registration form shall be his/her official number during the contest.

5. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly.
6. Winners per category will be identified per criteria by the Board of Judges
7. All winners will receive medals Certificate of Recognition
8. The panel of judges shall be composed of a Chairman and 2 members. The decision of the board of judges is final.

- Any group exceeding the maximum time allotment for the competition will be penalized as follows
- One minute or more over the maximum time allotment will be given a penalty of 5% subtracted from the total cumulative score

SLOGAN MAKING CONTEST

1. The contest is open to all permanent teachers currently in the service.
2. The slogan shall be based on the theme: **Saliksik at Gurong Pilipino: Kaakbay sa Progreso**
3. Slogan must be in **Filipino language** using a maximum of fifteen (15) words
4. All submitted entries must be original slogans and artwork that have not been published previously.
5. All contestants must submit a written explanation about their entries in not more than 100 words
6. The winner will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the general criteria below:

Relevance to the Theme	40%
Clarity of Message	20%
Creativity and Originality	30%
Impact and Presentation	10%
TOTAL	100%

7. The decision of the board of judges is final and cannot be appealed.

TEACHERS' PICTURE IN ACTION

1. The contest is open to all permanent teachers currently in the service.
2. By submitting the photograph for consideration, the teacher attests that:
 - a. Entry is original photograph
 - b. S/he created the image and owns full copyright to pictures submitted.
 - c. Photograph is actual focusing in one teacher only
 - d. Taken from last year (2016) picture
3. All contestants must submit a written explanation about their entries in not more than 100 words
4. The winner will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the general criteria below:

Authenticity of picture in action	40%
Appropriateness/Relevance to the Theme	20%
Shows significant moments	40%
TOTAL	100%

5. The decision of the board of judges is final and cannot be appealed.
