- 1. Relative to DepEd Memorandum No. 184, s. 2018, the City Schools Division of Tayabas announces the launching of the 2018 Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos-Award for Teachers sponsored by the Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), in cooperation with the Department of Education. It is the most prestigious award for Filipino exemplars in the academe, the military and the police which pays tribute to their excellence and sacrifices and for having gone over and beyond the call of duty to serve their profession and community.
- 2. Ten Filipino exemplars, (4 teachers, 3 soldiers and 3 police officers) are recognized annually for their initiatives and concrete contributions to the development of their sectors and communities. Since 1985, the Metrobank Foundation has honored 364 outstanding teachers in the country.
- The awardees shall receive a medal, trophy and cash incentive of PhP 1,000,000.00, part of which shall be allocated for the faculty development project, subject to the approval of the endorsing school and each national finalist shall receive PhP 50,000.
- 4. All winners of teaching-related local awards in the division or regional level are strongly encouraged to join, provided the eligibility requirements are met.
- 5. Elementary school heads are entitled to nominate two teachers, one each for the primary and intermediate levels while secondary school heads are entitled to only one nominee.

- 6. A nominee must be a Filipino citizen, permanent teacher with full teaching load, and meets the following requirements:
  - a. active in the service for at least 10 years with at least Very Satisfactory rating,
  - b. have at least completed academic requirements for Master's degree,
  - c. not on leave for more than 2 years prior to nomination
  - d. still have at least 3 years of remaining service before retirement
  - e. have valid PRC ID/license
  - f. not guilty of any administrative, civil or criminal case
- 7. There shall be a division synchronized announcement about the 2019 Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos-Award for Teachers in all schools during the Flag Raising Ceremony on **January 2**, **2019** using the enclosed invitation spiel for the announcement.
- 8. School heads are requested to submit the name of their teacher-nominee/s to this Office through HRD SEPS, Ms. Fideliza V. Luces not later than January 7, 2019. Both the School Head as nominator and the teacher-nominee shall attend a brief orientation with the OIC-ASDS on January 8, 2019, 3:00 p.m., at the division office.
