I. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE



The harvest of the diversity of expressions can be part of values education for patriotism, forging cultural identity and love of country, and affirming a heritage of defending a freedom legacy. This celebration aims to awaken pride of place, heritage, history, and language that will promote social justice and peace with the will to secure freedom from poverty.

II. OBJECTIVES

In general, the observance of this event has four (4) objectives:

- 11)Promotion of local cultural icons based on NCCA's Sagisag Kultura ng Filipinas;
- 12)Cultural awareness seminar workshop to local artists, art organizations, leaders and LGU staff; and

13)Special art program for the marginalized group in the community (Out-of-School Youth (OSY), Persons with Disabilities (PWDs), senior citizens, indigenous peoples, women and children).
