SUBJECT : SUBMISSION OF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE 2018 BSP NATIONAL LOWER AWARDS

- DECS ORDER No. 112, s. 1989 has revived the accreditation of BSP awards as incentives for meritorious services rendered to SCOUTING. It has also been reiterated in DepEd Order No. 68 s. 2003. Under DECS MERIT PROMOTION SYSTEM, maximum points shall be credited to plaque 1.25 points and medal – 2 points.
- All District/Municipal Scouting Committee are expected to submit its recommendations for National Awards <u>NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 12, 2017</u>. No recommendation shall be accepted after the deadline including additional recommendations.
- PRESCRIBED TIME INTERVAL OF TWO (2) YEARS BETWEEN AWARDS IN ALL GRADES AND CATEGORIES SHALL BE STRICTLY OBSERVED. Recommendations must be based on the extent of scouting services rendered.
- 4. There are three (3) categories of Awards (SERVICE AWARDS, MEDAL OF MERIT and Usa) and three (3) GRADES (BRONZE, SILVER and GOLD) in each category. The grant of a lower grade of award is a pre-requisite to higher grade in all categories.
- 5. All districts/schools are given a fixed quota for BRONZE SERVICE grades in all categories. RECOMMENDEES FOR THIS GRADE SHALL NOT EXCEED 10% OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF REGISTERED ADULTS AS OF DECEMBER 15. In case where the number of nominees submitted has exceeded the district's quota, the list shall be made in the order of priority since consideration thereof will be based on the order of listing.
- 6. All recommendations for various awards MUST:
 - 6.1. STATE INDIVIDUAL ACHIEVEMENTS WHICH MUST BE BRIEF, CONCISE AND SPECIFIC;
 - 6.2. HAVE FULL NAME CORRECTLY SPELLED INCLUDING MIDDLE INITIAL, DATE OF REGISTRATION, AUR NUMBER AND DATE OF PREVIOUS AWARDS RECEIVED; and
 - 6.3. HAVE THE REQUIRED SIGNATURE. CONFIDENTIALITY OF RECOMMENDATION SHALL BE STRICTLY OBSERVED.
- 7. Attached is an AWARD FORM to be filled up properly. SUBMISSION OF RECOMMENDATION WHICH WILL NOT ADHERE TO ITEM NO. 6 SHALL BE RETURNED OUTRIGHT FOR CORRECTION.
