


Other activities in line with the celebration are open from 10:15am to 5:00 pm.

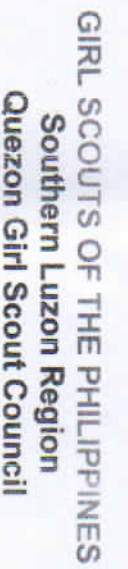
