In line with DepEd's thrust to accelerate the implementation of School-Based Management (SBM) as a key component of Basic Education Reform Agenda, this office announces the ASSESSMENT OF SBM LEVEL OF PRACTICE FOR 2017-2018.

This initiative shall provide an avenue for school heads to identify gaps in relation to efficient and effective school operations, specifically on the Four Principles of School-Based Management.

It shall further help school heads identify the extent of involvement of their internal and external stakeholders in the attainment of the objectives of their programs, projects and activities.

Specifically, the three-day Seminar-Workshop to be conducted on **May 23-25, 2018** in **ORN, Luis Palad Integrated High School** aims to:

1. determine the level of SBM practices of each school;
2. identify strengths and weaknesses of the schools in relation to the 4 principles of SBM;
3. help school heads identify basis on which to establish plan of action for SY 2018-2019;
4. determine the effectiveness of SBM practices in the delivery of basic education services;
5. help school heads align their SBM practices with their OPCRf; and
6. give technical assistance to school heads in mobilizing their respective School Governing Council


