4. The mechanics of presentation and some instructions are enumerated below:

FOR ALL CONCERNED ATTENDEES:

All the identified participants, Moderator / Timekeepers, encoders and members of the panel of evaluators must confirm through the online link, bit.ly/06SHDPCOL not later than September 9, 2019 (Monday), 5:00 pm.

For the presenters:

- a. There must be a five (5) minute video presentation highlighting the context of your project, its implementation, processes and milestones it has achieved so far, as well as significant accomplishments. Such video must be uploaded to this link, bit.ly/06SHDPCOLVID not later than August 30, 2019 (Friday), 5:00 pm. Video file shall be given filename using the code assigned (see list and schedule above.). Signing in your deped.gov.ph account is required before you can upload.
- b. Bring hardcopy of APIP during the day of the colloquium.
- c. **Per each SDO, there must be at least one (1) complete set of equipment such as laptop, portable speaker, USB and set of peripherals to play the video so as not to experience hassle. The videos may not play when downloaded from different formats. Just to make sure it will not fail. Your video must be PRE-TESTED using the compatible computer available during the presentation.**
- d. Come in the venue in corporate attire.
- e. Observe ten (10) minute limit during the presentation (5 minutes video presentation and 5 minutes Question and Answer.)
- f. Be open and courteous at all times during the colloquium.

For the Panel of Evaluators

- a. Review the Application Project Implementation Paper (APIP) sent to your official email. Those presenters who failed to submit their APIP shall provide you hard copy (one per each evaluator.)
- b. Be guided with the rubrics to rate the APIP. E-copy of the rating sheet is e-mailed.
- c. Ask objective questions and make constructive comments and suggestions for improvement of the project.
- d. Rate the APIP completely and submit the duly signed rating sheet to the tabulator.
- e. **There must be at least 30 minutes deliberation before closing the session. Privately call each presenter and show his/her final rating and remarks.**

For the Moderator / Timekeeper / Tabulator/Encoder

- a. Lead the colloquium and manage time efficiently and effectively.
- b. Ensure availability of all the needed materials during the colloquium.
- c. Prepare and accomplish a checklist of resource materials which include, **one (1) envelope with 1 stapler, 1 ballpen, 1 notebook, fifty (50) sheets of rubrics, five (5) pencils, one (1) LDP/ LCD Projector per each Class, one (1) computer/ laptop, one (1) audio or sound system/ speakers, TEN (10) name tags (Use CODE for the presenter).**
- d. Observe protocols and processes that the management will provide.
- e. The moderator and timekeeper shall assist the tabulator in gathering the rating sheets. Tabulator shall encode all at once the scores in the automated spreadsheets. Presenter deserves to know his/her score during the deliberation.

For the Management/ Secretariat

- a. Do the overall coordination with the training venue, equipment, facilities and all provisions to ensure quality implementation of colloquium.
 - b. Ensure sufficiency of all logistical resources needed during the colloquium.
 - c. Design a feedback mechanism to monitor and evaluate the colloquium.
