SUBJECT : **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION RE: 9th SOUTHERN TAGALOG
REGIONAL KID AND KABSAYAHAN**

1. The activities of the 2019 Southern Tagalog Regional KID/KABSayaan will revolve around the theme, **"Iskawting: Patuloy na Paninindigan sa Kahusayan Tungo sa Kaunlaran"**.
2. Hereunder listed are the Guidelines of the following events, to wit:
 - I- Search for the **"That's My KAB"** will be held at the Event Center of the Pacific Mall, Lucena City, which will start at exactly 9:00 in the morning of **06 September 2019** and in charge of the event is **CSE Cecille A. Manicad** of Laguna Council and **CSE Victoria C. De Vera** of San Pablo City Council.

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

A. Mechanics:

1. Number of Candidates: There shall be only one (1) Candidate per Council.
2. Qualifications/Requirements: A Candidate must:
 - 2.1. At least 7 y/o to 9 y/o only;
 - 2.2. Be duly registered as KAB Scout supported by a Membership Card and a copy of the AUR.
 - 2.3. Must be endorsed by the Council Scout Executive.
 - 2.4. Have a School & Parent's permit; and
 - 2.5. Be at the venue of September 06, 2019 at 8:00 A.M. with accompanying adults: (Parent, Kawan Leader, Trainer/Coach)

B. Procedure/Method:

1. The Orientation/Briefing on the Search for the "That's My KAB" 2019 will start at 8:00 a.m. of Friday, September 06, 2019.
2. The picture taking for the "Most Photogenic" contest will be held during the Orientation/Briefing period. The Candidate must be in Type "B" KAB Scout uniform.
3. The following "Special Awards" contest will be awarded to the following:

3.1 Best in Formal Attire (Barong Tagalog)

20 points

- 5 pts. - Smartness and Neatness
- 5 pts. - Poise and Bearing
- 8 pts. - Good Looking and Personality
- 2 pts. - Overall Impact

3.2 Best in Type "B" KAB Scout Uniform.

20 points

- 5 pts. - Smartness and Neatness
- 5 pts. - Poise and Bearing
- 5 pts. - Good Looking and Personality
- 5 pts. - Completeness

3.3 Best in Talent

30 points

- 15 pts. - Mastery
- 10 pts. - Expression and Creativity
- 5 pts. - Overall Impact

4. The KAB Scout Candidate, the trainer/coach, and the Kawan Leader shall be given framed Certificate of Recognition.
5. Back-up performers will strictly not be allowed during the "Talent" portion; however stage props and sounds will be permitted.
6. The talent presentation will be limited to a minimum of three (3) minutes but not more than five (5) minutes (maximum). In excess of the allotted time, the candidate will be deducted one (1) point for every minute or of its fraction.
7. Setting up and removal of the stage props shall be limited to a maximum of five (5) minutes; thus every contestant is entitled to only (10) minutes.

3.4 Question & Answer and Personality for all candidates:

1. The Candidates shall be in **Type "B" KAB Scout uniform** during the "Question and Answer" period.
2. Only one (1) Question will be prepared by the Search Committee.
3. The Contestants/Candidates shall leave the hall and stay in a holding room where the sound from the hall cannot be heard. Only one (1) member of the Search Committee shall act as marshal and stay inside the holding room until all the contestants shall have left.
4. Cell phones shall be strictly restricted inside the holding room. A contestant using a cell phone inside the holding room shall be automatically disqualified from the contest.
5. Scoring: "Question & Answer" - - - **30 points**

Criteria for Judging:

- 20% - Poise and Stage Presence **(6 Points)**
- 50% - Intelligence, Substance, Organization of thoughts **(15 Points)**
- 30% - Wit and Depth of the Answer **(9 Points)**

C. Awards and Recognitions:

- d.1. The five (5) Over-all Winners in the Search for "That's My KAB" shall be recognized as follows:
 - a. THAT'S MY KAB
 - b. 1st Runner-Up
 - c. 2nd Runner-Up
 - d. 3rd Runner-Up
 - e. 4th Runner-Up
 - f. Most Photogenic (in Type "B" KAB Scout Uniform)
- d.2 Each winner shall be presented the following awards/recognitions: Plaque/Trophy, Certificate/ Medal
- D. We will highly appreciate everyone to give due respect to the integrity and reputation of the Board of Judges whose decision is final.
- E. The Board of Judges will compose a Chairman and Two (2) members.
- F. The Awarding Ceremony for all categories shall follow immediately after the Search.

- II- Singing KID Scouts** will start on **06 September 2019**. Each **Council is entitled to only one (1) participant**. They will sing one after each presentation of the candidates for the **That's my KAB. Drawing of Lots will be done at 9:00 A.M. on 06 September 2019**. Events In-Charge are **CSE Cecille A. Manicad** of Laguna Council and **CSE Victoria de Vera** of the San Pablo City Council.

Guidelines for Participation:

- Participant:** One (1) KID Scout
- Piece:** Any Song
- Accompaniment:** Any accompaniment
- Time Allotment:** minimum of Three (3) minutes and maximum of five (5) minutes
- Attire:** KID Scout type 'B' uniform.
