SUBJECT : INDUCTION PROGRAM FOR NEWLY-HIRED TEACHERS

DATE : SEPTEMBER 04, 2019

1. Republic Act 10533 or enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013 Section 7 states that DepEd and the Commission of Higher Education (CHED), in collaboration with relevant partners in government, academe, industry and non-government organizations (NGOs) shall conduct teacher education and training programs to ensure that the enhanced basic education meets the demand for quality teachers and school leaders. support of the Department's policy development process, research agenda, and policy and program development and implementation, the Schools Division of Tayabas City continues to promote and strengthen the culture of research in basic education.

2. To support this program, the schools Division of Tayabas will conduct the 4 day-training on the Implementation of the TIP Program on September 6, 13, 20, 27, 2019 at Tayabas City Division Stand Alone Senior High School (TCDSASHS).

3. New teachers shall undergo additional training, upon hiring, to upgrade their skills to the content standards of the K to 12 Basic Education Program (BEP).

Specifically, the training aims to:

- enhance skills of newly-hired teachers on DepEd order no. 43 s. 2017;
- help teachers gain deeper understanding on the TIP Policy; and
- help teachers strengthen their commitment in the teaching profession.

4. The participants of this activity are the newly-hired teachers with 0-3 years teaching experience. The list is hereby attached.



5. Participants are expected to bring their Modules 1 and 2 (with answers) for in-depth discussion during the sessions.
6. The registration fee amounting Php 2,000 for 4 days per pax, for 1 lunch and 2 snacks per day, shall be charged to the school MOOE subject to usual accounting rules and procedures.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
