**SUBJECT : OBSERVANCE OF THE 2019 DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION
AND CONTROL (DAPC) WEEK**

DATE : OCTOBER 25, 2019

1. In observance of the **2019 Drug Abuse Prevention and Control (DAPC) Week** and in adherence to DepEd Memorandum 128, s. 2019, this office informs the field on the 2019 Drug Abuse Prevention and Control (DAPC) Week Celebration with the theme, *Katarungan para sa Kalusugan, Kalusugan para sa Katarungan*, which will be held from November 17 to 23, 2019. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 124 dated November 26, 2001 entitled **Declaring the 3rd Week of November of Every Year as Drug Abuse Prevention and Control (DAPC) Week.**

2. The celebration aims to make people aware of the dangers posed by drug abuse, and to further strengthen their resolve to do their share in the fight against this menace.

3. All public and private elementary and secondary schools are enjoined to organize educational and social activities to celebrate the occasion. Each school is required to conduct and accomplish 2 activities in the preliminary and during the week from the suggested list below.

a. Preliminary Activities

- i. Putting up of bulletin displays depicting the theme in strategic places in the schools.
- ii. Radio broadcast announcing the DAPC Week Celebration;
- iii. Coordination with the local government units (LGUs) such as municipal and barangay officials, parents-teachers association (PTAs), and nongovernment organizations (NGOs) related to the week's activities.



b. Activities during the Week

- i. School-community parade
 - ii. Intensive educational campaign against drug abuse, through symposia, seminal, film showing, community assemblies, school PTA meetings/conferences and print broadcast media;
 - iii. Contests, such as slogan and essay writing, poster making, printing/drawing/sketching, composition of jingles, rhymes, and songs;
 - iv. Integration of the drug abuse prevention concepts in appropriate subject/learning areas at the elementary and secondary levels; and
 - v. Holding exhibits and shows.
4. The Medical Team, select SGOD and the EPS-MAPEH personnel shall have their monitoring of the aforementioned activities. (See Enclosure 1)
5. A brief narrative and pictorial report on the observance of DAPC Week shall be submitted to the Division Office, Health and Nutrition Section (Medical Section) not later than December 9, 2019.
6. Strict compliance of this memorandum is desired.
