1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), shall implement the School Dental Health Care Program (SDHCP) to ensure the maintenance of good oral health of the school population through institutionalized holistic approach in the prevention and treatment of oral diseases. In line with this, the City Schools Division of the City of Tayabas will conduct an orientation in SDHCP to be held on December 17, 2019. Venue will be announced in a separate advisory.

2. This activity aims the participants to:

a. understand the guidelines on the implementation of the said program and to help build linkages on possible stakeholders

b. promote oral health and prevent oral diseases

c. provide preventive and curative dental services among learners
