September 16 Sunday	 DAY 1 - THANKSGIVING DAY "Understanding One's Faith" Suggested Activities: Actively participate in a Worship Service. (Holy Mass, Prayer meetings, Praise and Thanksgiving Service, Sabbath, etc.) Share stories of faith and daily miracles with your family, friends and peers. Challenge yourself to Be the Change Promote a culture of respect through the following: Look at people from other faith as persons, not as categories or religions. Educate yourself. Learn about other faiths and customs. Look for similarities. Keep an open mind. Be mindful not to offend others when talking about religion.
September 17 Monday	 DAY 2 - ENVIRONMENT DAY "Girls in Green for Mother Earth" Suggested Activities: Initiate or join a community project like coastal clean-up, tree planting, beautification of an area, vegetable gardening, etc. Hold a small group bike ride in a scenic part of the community and immerse yourself in the calm of the environment Help reduce plastic waste by avoiding the use of disposable cups, plates, straw, spoon and forks, etc. Make and post on your Facebook account memes, slogan and posters on reducing plastic wastes. Trace footsteps of our founder: Take a selfie or group as you visit sites and places relative to JLE and give a trivia on how it is related to JLE.
