

Poster	Tarpaulin or Tarpapel
Size	5' x 3' (Portrait orientation)
Posting Method	Proponents shall mount the posters on the panels provided by the Batangas State University
Posting Schedule	Set-up: 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. of October 18, 2018 Take-down: 5:00 p.m. of October 18, 2018
Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Title• Author/s (presenter's name underlined)• Email address• Affiliations (University/College/Department of all authors)• Abstract• Introduction (background and significance)• Methodology• Discussion of Results• Conclusion• Recommendations or future directions• Acknowledgement (if any)• References
Notes	Headings and textual discussion must be concise but informative. Graphs and figures must be of high resolution and have informative captions. Submit electronic file of the poster to researchforum4a@gmail.com with the subject: For Poster Presentation – Category on or before October 5, 2018 (Friday) .
Recommended Font	Tahoma. Must be readable within half-a-meter distance.
Presenter's Physical Presence	The presenter should be present during the scheduled poster viewing sessions (from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.) to answer questions from the viewers.

The forum aims to showcase the findings of the research studies to promote the culture of research and strengthen the statistical capacities of academic institutions, government agencies and local government units in the region.

The RRC/CRRC call for the submission of quality research papers from the academe, research institutions (public and private) and consortia containing results and findings relevant to the following fields of research:

- I. Industry and Services
- II. Agriculture, Hunting Forestry and Fisheries
- III. Infrastructure
- IV. Social Development (Health, Education, Gender, etc.)
- V. Governance
- VI. Environmental protection and natural resources management

Research papers submitted may address more than one field.

Participating Research Paper

The call is open to all scientists and researchers (group or individual) from Calabarzon state universities and colleges, R&D institutions, higher education institutions, and private industries doing R&D work.

Submission of Research Papers

Paper presenters to submit the following:

- accomplished registration form
- one-page Abstract in pdf format, 250-350 words including keywords, single spaced, font: Arial 11
- Endorsement by head of agency/institution

General Guidelines

Research paper submissions must be completed within the past five years. Only **unpublished** research papers will be accepted. All submissions will be reviewed by the Calabarzon RDC-RRC. Principal authors may submit a maximum of two papers. Research papers that are not compliant with the required format and not relevant to the fields of research identified will not be accepted. Qualified papers will be notified to submit their full paper on or before May 18 (Friday). The RRC will not tolerate plagiarism or other similar acts.
