## Regional Memorandum

## REGIONAL READINESS SHOWCASE AND 'PAGPUPUGAY SA GURONG PILIPINO'

To

Schools Division Superintendents School Heads Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel

- The Department of Education (DepEd) IV-A CALABARZON recognizes the efforts and contribution of the 21 Schools Division Offices (SDO), parents, LGUs and other stakeholders who work together to overcome challenges to ensure the implementation of Basic Education - Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) in the region.
- Likewise, teachers, school heads and non-teaching personnel have played significant roles with their participation in different activities related to the conduct of schools LCP implementation dry runs, a solid display of their support to the Department's call to continue the delivery of basic education in the face of a pandemic.
- 3. In this connection, DepEd CALABARZON will be holding the **Regional Readiness Showcase and 'Pagpupugay sa Gurong Pilipino'** program to underscore the readiness of the region for the school opening on October 5 and recognize the contribution of teachers in pushing for the BE-LCP implementation.
- 4. The Regional Readiness Showcase and 'Pagpupugay sa Gurong Pilipino' is a virtual program to be held on September 30, 2020 in collaboration with SDO Rizal Province via Facebook Live on the official FB pages of the regional office: DepEd R-4A Calabarzon, DepEd Tayo Calabarzon and Pivot Calabarzon YouTube channel.
- 5. As a prelude to the highlight virtual program, a premier of the best schools LCP implementation dry runs from each SDO as well as video presentations of teachers' support to BE-LCP will be shown from September 23 to 29, 2020 via the official FB pages and Youtube channel of the region.



- 6. Relative to this, SDOs are expected to adhere to and prepare the following:
  - a. Five-minute video compilation of choice/best schools LCP implementation dry runs. Videos will showcase activities connected with schools LCP implementation dry runs and should adhere to the assigned theme.
  - b. Follow the theme assigned to each SDO. Below is the schedule and assigned themes in creating the five-minute video:

- c. Submitted videos' orientation should be in landscape and size is <u>not</u> <u>more than 1080</u>p. This is to facilitate editing and downloading of videos.
- d. **Deadline of video submission.** All SDOs are expected to submit their fiveminute videos <u>on or before Monday, 21 September 2020 before 5pm</u> using this link: **bit.ly/4AReadinessShowcase**.
- e. Submit a photo of their LGU leader/s receiving or holding the Plaque of Appreciation from the Regional office. SDSs will award the plaque to their respective LGU (city, municipality, provincial and congressional) leader/s. Photos of the LGU leader with the plaque may be emailed to pau.calabarzon@deped.gov.ph and ict.calabarzon@deped.gov.ph on or before Friday, 25 September 2020 for consolidation.

- 7. On 30 September 2020, the conduct of the virtual Regional Readiness Showcase and 'Pagpupugay sa Gurong Pilipino', being the highlight of the week-long presentations, will focus on DepEd CALABARZON's readiness for the school opening on October 5, recognize supportive LGU leaders and honor all CALABARZON teachers who have worked diligently to ensure that education in the region will continue.
- 8. All SDOs and schools DepEd Tayo Official Facebook page admins are encouraged to send crossposting request to DepEd R-4A Calabarzon official FB page admin of the regional office in order to allow simultaneous posting of the virtual program on September 30.
